This document presents four new tabulations of the CJK Basic Strokes proposed in N2817 = L2/04-221 (see also L2/03-387 = IRGN986, L2/03-404 = IRGN985, and L2/03-420 = IRGN987). The repertory presented here is identical with that proposed in N2817 (and given with analysis and supporting forms in IRGN987), with the addition of item "24*" from HKSCS (see note 2 on page 2 below).

On the basis of the draft mappings assigned in "04287-n2832-pdam1-sum.pdf", we distinguish between the 16 CJK Basic Strokes which already have mappings in *pdam1*, and those 24 which do not. This information is given in the following two tables:

Table 1, "24 CDL Additions to the CJK Basic Strokes Block," beginning on page 3, and

Table 2, "Repertory of the CJK Basic Strokes Block," beginning on page 5.

Addition of these 24 CJK Basic Strokes results in a total of 40 characters assigned to the new block.

Table 3, "Consolidated Repertory, Unified Order," beginning on page 9, presents all characters for the new block in the traditional "five-types" arrangement explained in the analysis given in L2/03-420 = IRGN987. This arrangement has several advantages over the random order that would result from the assignments given in *pdam1*. It will be easier for users to locate a needed character by consulting a traditionally ordered code chart. Related stroke types are found near one another, and common stroke types are listed before uncommon ones. There are also implications for sorting, since when using the order given in Table 3 and Table 4 sorting by code point results in a traditional "five-types" sort order (no external sorting table will be required).

Table 4, "CJK Basic Strokes: Unified Repertory, Ordering, and Names," beginning on page 13, lays out the full block of *CJK Basic Strokes*, in the preferred order, with corrected names (see notes 1 and 3 below), in code chart format.

Notes

- 1. The name "SW" assigned to U+31C4 (item 18) in Table 2 reflects a correction of *pdam1*. According to the glyph shapes, the name "SZ" is properly assigned to U+31DD in Table 1.
- 2. Item "24*" in Table 2 is not from the CJK Basic Strokes proposed in L2/04-221, but derives from the set of HKSCS PUA characters (see N2832, N2807, N2808; IRGN1024=L2/04-161). In the CDL system this stroke was recognized as a non-distinctive variant in *Song*-style text of item 32 "SWG". It is however distinctive in *Kai*, and strictly speaking, is not a *Song* stroke at all, but a *Kai* stroke (within *Kai* itself both 24* and 32 are distinguished; 24* is the only stroke type unique to the *Kai* style). It is introduced into the current proposal to accomodate the HKSCS character. Its position after "24" as a type-5 stroke reflects the close graphical relation of these two strokes, both of which have a single *zhe* 'bend' and 3 control points (see the *CDL Specification*, IRGN987).
- 3. Rather than naming item 24* "XG-2", we propose using the name "WOG" (short for 臥鉤 wogou, the Chinese name for this stroke), which would be consistent with the CDL naming conventions of the other strokes.
- 4. Table 1 assigns UCS mappings to the new characters sequentially, beginning with the first open slot in *pdam1*, i.e. U+31D0.
- 5. Table 2 leaves the new characters with mappings "----", so that they are visusally distinct.
- 6. Table 3 presents the consolidated repertory in the preferred order. Consult this table for conversion of the *pdam1* mappings to the current mappings.
- 7. In Tables 1, 2 and 3 the "#" column contains the numbers from the original proposal (N2817).
