This project will reissue a consolidated edition of ISO/IEC 14651 edition 1 plus its three first amendments (which was synchronized with the repertoire of ISO/IEC 10646:2003 and its amendment 1) and incorporate in addition an updated international common template table, to align it with the combined character repertoires of ISO/IEC 10646:2003 and its amendments 1 and 2.

Purpose and justification

The ongoing development of the universal, multi-octet-coded character set makes the development of the String Ordering Standard mandatory.
