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This document describes additions and errata to ISO/IEC 10646:2003 that the US National body would like to see integrated in the standard. The items in this category are considered mature enough that the US National body would not object to see them added in the currently balloted draft of Amendment 4, but these additions could also be proposed in a future amendment if deemed more appropriate.

1. Addition of Additional Orthographic and Modifier Characters

The US is in favor of adding the following 4 characters as proposed by document WG2 N3216 (L2/06-259R) at the following positions:

The changes from WG2 N3194 are the move of the newly proposed Cyrillic Extended-B block from A6C0-A6FF to A640-A67F, the removal of the characters A6E0-A6E1 (now holes in A660-A661), and the move of the SLAVONIC ASTERISK from 2E3A to A673).

The repertoire addition is quite large but it affects a repertoire (Cyrillic) being balloted in PDAM4, as such it is reasonable to add them in the next phase of that amendment.
