SC 2/WG2 seeks the SC2's and subsequently JTC 1's endorsement for adding the following subproject to its Program of Work.

Title: Information technology -- Universal Multiple-Octet Coded Character Set (UCS) –

**Scope:** Incorporate 1743 characters for CJK Extension D (223), Bamum (596), Alchemical symbols (116), Ethiopic Extended-A (34), Emoji symbols (748) and miscellaneous character additions (26).

**Rationale:** The proposed scripts and characters are based on contributions from several national body, liaison organizations and other expert linguists. These proposed characters were approved at meeting 54 of JTC1/SC2/WG2 held in April 2009 by Resolution M54.14 SC2/WG2 N N3604 contains the list of these additional scripts and characters for this amendment. Here is a summary:
