Please refer the proposal for Encoding of Grantha in Unicode submitted by Govt. of India. Based on the concerns expressed by Government of Tamil Nadu, Govt of India requested Unicode Consortium to defer the decision on the Grantha encoding. Government of Tamil Nadu had constituted a committee to examine the various issues with respect to encoding of Grantha. The committee has submitted its report to Government of Tamil Nadu.

The gist of the recommendations of the committee has been communicated to Govt. of India by Govt. of Tamil Nadu. Based on the recommendation of Govt. of Tamil Nadu, Govt. of India provisionally recommends that the following seven characters may be treated as withdrawn from the earlier Gol proposal (L2/10-426):
