Subject: Name change for U+16FE0

On 8 May 2014, the UTC approved U+16FE0 TANGUT REPETITION MARK in the Ideographic Symbols and Punctuation block. However, ISO/IEC 10646:2014/FDAM2 has the name TANGUT ITERATION MARK for the same character. The FDAM2 ballot passed and was approved in March 2016 and consequently, TANGUT ITERATION MARK is the name we have used in the 9.0 UCD data files currently in beta review. Hence we recommend the UTC change the name for U+16FE0 to TANGUT ITERATION MARK to be in synch with ISO/IEC 10646.
