Introduction

Hindko language is spoken in Pakistan northern region and is written in Arabic script. Gandhara Hindko Board is a nonprofit organization working on standardizing Hindko alphabets and publishing books in Hindko.

There are some alphabets in this language which are currently not supported in Unicode. In this proposal I want to present those characters to Unicode teams for their inclusion.


