Attached are two working documents on the Bété script by Andrij Rovenchak. At this time, additional information is being collected by Chuck Riley and Andrij Rovenchak in order to address the questions posed by the Script Ad Hoc in L2/19-047. Chuck Riley is in touch with the user community.

1. *Bété syllabary ordered graphically* (pp. 2-23)

In this document, the characters were ordered graphically, which was recommended during discussions of the Script Ad Hoc.

The red highlighted characters indicate the duplicate shapes which might be removed from the encoding proposal, yellow indicates duplicate shapes which does not occur as single shapes and are suggested to be encoded, and green are used to indicate interim highlighting (but which are irrelevant for the purposes here).

2. *On Bété script* (pp. 24-26)
