This document describes additions to ISO/IEC 10646 that the Unicode Consortium would like to see integrated in the standard. The items in this category are considered mature enough for inclusion in the standard. We recommend all of the following be targeted for a future edition or amendment.

1. Lisu Supplement

The Unicode Consortium requests the addition of 1 character U+11FB0 LISU LETTER YHA in a new block “Lisu Supplement” that extends from U+11FB0..U+11FBF with the glyph and properties as documented in [L2/18-338](#).

2. Oriya

The Unicode Consortium requests the addition of 1 character U+0B55 ORIYA SIGN OVERLINE with the glyph and properties as documented in [L2/19-005](#).

3. Syloti Nagri

The Unicode Consortium requests the addition of 1 character U+A82C SYLOTI NAGRI SIGN ALTERNATE HASANTA with the glyph and properties as documented in [L2/19-024](#).

4. Supplemental Arrows-C

The Unicode Consortium requests the addition of 2 characters U+1F8B0 ARROW POINTING UPWARDS THEN NORTH WEST and U+1F8B1 ARROW POINTING RIGHTWARDS THEN CURVING SOUTH WEST with the glyphs and properties as documented in [L2/19-025](#).

5. Symbols for Legacy Computing

The Unicode Consortium requests the addition of 212 characters in a new block “Symbols for Legacy Computing” at U+1FB00..U+1FBFF with glyphs and properties as documented in [L2/19-025](#).

6. Enclosed Alphanumeric Supplement

The Unicode Consortium requests the addition of 1 character U+1F1AD MASK WORK SYMBOL with the glyph and properties as documented in [L2/18-339r](#).
