1. So where is real evidence from ordinary text? You need to provide sufficient evidence from newspapers, books, or other publications. The evidence should not be related to the *New (North) Korean Orthography* itself.

2. Even if some jamo letters got encoded without sufficient evidence (I don't know if this is true or not), they are water under the bridge at this point. Once a character is encoded, it cannot be removed. "Some jamo letters got encoded without sufficient evidence" (does not matter whether this is true or not) is not a valid reason to encode additional jamo letters without sufficient real evidence.

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
