
A. Compatibility

2. Multiple usages


Wings fit within many tropes with a broad range of symbolism.






















4. Breaking new ground

F. Overly specific

No. While there are many colors and types of wings this emoji is what has come to become the prototypical style — simple, white, and open..

G. Open-ended

No. There are four types of <u>Wing Shapes</u>: Passive/Active Soaring, Elliptical wings, High speed wings, and hovering wings. This wing is broad enough to reasonably represent all four types.

H. Already representable

No. While I originally thought perhaps the bird emoji was sufficiently emblematic of "flying", two major messaging platforms don't even show the bird emoji WITH wings (really?? really.)



I also considered "airplane" emoji as a suitable "already representable" substitute but found that in identical sequences (listed above) it does not capture the long-standing range that a wing embodies
