

Proposal to encode 23 Cyrillic characters for old Uslar's Caucasian Alphabets

in ISO/IEC 10646 and The Unicode Standard

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2022-09-18

1. Introduction

In this document, it is proposed to add 23 additional Cyrillic letters that were in the pre-revolutionary Caucasian alphabets of Uslar (Abkhazian, Lak, Tabasaran, Avar, Chechen, Dargin, Lezgin, Tsakhur alphabets). Some of the letters are similar to Georgian and Armenian letters.

Note: The Tabasaran alphabet was not used due to the death of the author, it remained in the manuscript and was never used in practice.




