1. Introduction

This document is an addendum to <u>L2/25-042</u>, as I found the second to last example to be unsatisfactory. The *Dragon Ball* title card in question has smaller sized Katakana Ne not in a similar vein to the surrounding examples, but rather because each segment of the text has each of the various scripts used when writing Japanese displayed in varying font-sizes. As such, this document seeks to replace that faulty example with a number of superior attestations. Each of these do not vary the font-sizes within the segment of text containing the Small Katakana Ne; the characters are consistently sized except for the expected Small Kana.






