 • the Q-shaped archaic koppas are the ordinary alphabetic letters
- 03DA Ϛ GREEK LETTER STIGMA
 • apparently in origin a cursive form of digamma
 • the name “stigma” originally applied to a medieval sigma-tau ligature, whose shape was confusably similar to the cursive digamma
 • used as a symbol with a numeric value of 6
- 03DB ϛ GREEK SMALL LETTER STIGMA
 → 03C2 Ϛ greek small letter final sigma
- 03DC Ϝ GREEK LETTER DIGAMMA
- 03DD ϝ GREEK SMALL LETTER DIGAMMA
 • used as a symbol with a numeric value of 6
- 03DE Ϟ GREEK LETTER KOPPA
- 03DF ϟ GREEK SMALL LETTER KOPPA
 • used in modern Greek as a symbol with a numeric value of 90, as in the dating of legal documentation
- 03E0 Ϡ GREEK LETTER SAMPI

 • used as a symbol with a numeric value of 900
