SC 2 seeks the JTC 1's endorsement for adding the following subproject to its Programme of Work.

Title: Information technology -- Universal Multiple-Octet Coded Character Set (UCS) --
AMDNDMENT 1: Glagolitic, Coptic, Georgian and other characters

Scope: Incorporate an additional 810 characters for Glagolitic, Coptic, Georgian and other characters.

Rationale: The proposed characters are based on contributions from several national body, liaison organizations and other linguists. These proposed characters were approved at the 44th WG 2 meeting held October 2003 by Resolution M44.10. The project subdivision proposal for this amendment was balloted by the SC 2 P-members as SC 2 N 3696 and approved on 31 January 2004. The Summary of Voting is contained in SC 2 N 3713.
