The Irish National Body is in favour of adding the following items to ISO/IEC 10646:2003 Amendment 3.

1. New Myanmar characters

Ireland is in favour of adding the following seven Myanmar characters (see N3043, N3061). We believe that the addition of these characters to PDAM3 would be the best way for WG2 to respond to the consensus of implementors in the Union of Myanmar, who unanimously support the addition of these characters which, in addition to simplifying the representation of the Burmese language, permit the representation of features of minority languages in the Union of Myanmar which cannot otherwise be met by the current standard.

Ireland is in favour of adding the following four Egyptian transliteration characters (see N2241). We do not consider these to be urgent; our desire for these to be added to PDAM3 is not as strong as that for the Myanmar characters above.
