This document describes additions to ISO/IEC 10646:2003 that the US National body would like to see integrated in the standard. They are classified in 3 categories:

- 1) Additions that should preferably be done in the currently balloted amendment (3.2)
- 2) Additions for which the US has no preference for either the current or next amendment.
- 3) Addition that should preferably be done in a future amendment.

# **Current Amendment (3.2)**

The items in this category are considered mature enough that the US National body would not object to see them added in the currently balloted draft of Amendment 3.2, but these additions could also be proposed in a future amendment if deemed more appropriate.

## 1. Addition of Old Cyrillic characters

The US is in favor of adding the following 22 Old Cyrillic characters as proposed by document WG2 N3097 (L2/06-172) at the following positions:

Concerning the characters proposed for 2B41 and 2B42, the original proposal had a mismatch between the glyphs and the name, showing reversed 'tilde' and 'almost equal to' glyph fragments while giving names without the 'reversed' qualification. Adding 'reversed' to the name for 2B41 should not be controversial. However using 'reversed almost equal' for 2B42 may not convey the right meaning because in a mirrored context the intent is to convey the meaning of 'almost equal to'.
