This document describes additions to ISO/IEC 10646 that the U.S. National Body would like to see integrated in the standard. The items in this category are considered mature enough for inclusion in the standard. We recommend all of the following be targeted for inclusion in a future edition or amendment.

1. Mongolian Square Script

The U.S. requests the addition of 67 characters in a new Mongolian Square block that extends from U+11A00 to U+11A4F, with glyphs and properties as documented in WG2 N4471.

2. Arabic Extended-A

The U.S. requests the addition of four Arabic letters, with glyphs and properties as given in WG2 N4498:

U+08B6 ARABIC LETTER BEH WITH SMALL MEEM ABOVE

U+08B7 ARABIC LETTER PEH WITH SMALL MEEM ABOVE

U+08B9 ARABIC LETTER REH WITH SMALL NOON ABOVE

U+08BA ARABIC LETTER YEH WITH TWO DOTS BELOW AND SMALL NOON ABOVE
