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This document contains the proposal for the amendment of Korean character name in ISO/IEC 10646-1:2000, and its more detailed additional evidences.

" Hangul " in ISO/IEC 10646-1:2000 means the " Hanguk letters in syllable-unit" as specified KS C 5601, so it cannot be specified in ISO/IEC 10646-1:2000 as normative Korean character name.

CSK propose, as proposed in SC2 N3393, WG2 N2056, WG2 N2170, to change the Korean character names in ISO/IEC 106464-1:2000 as follows:

- " Hangul Jamo " to "Korean Alphabets"
- " Hangul Syllables" to "Korean Syllables"

The followings are some of the historical evidences related to the Korean character names.

1. The figure below shows the part of ISO IR 149 where the name of Korean alphabet is specified as "Korean Alphabet".

#### 1.3 Hangul Alphabet

This group comprises the 93 letters of the Korean alphabet and 1 position denoting the absence of a consonant. 2. The figure below shows the cover sheet of GB 12052-89 where the name of Korean character is specified as "Korean character".
