### 1. SUMMARY

Mappings for 49 characters of ISO 10574 were approved by ISO/TC 46/SC 4/WG 1 in May 2000. The finalized mappings are shown in Section 3. Two characters from this character set were rejected by WG2 at Meeting 35 (London, U.K.: September 1998).

Mappings for 16 more characters were subsequently identified. The additional mappings are shown in Section 4. These will need to be approved by ISO/TC 46/SC 4/WG 1 when it next meets.

The 26 characters that still lack mappings are listed in Section 2. They may be categorized as:

- a) 6 letters with strokes
- b) 4 letters that may actually be typographical ligatures
- c) 6 letters that may be variants of existing letters
- d) 8 letters that may be considered clones of Latin letters
- e) 2 other letters

## 2. CHARACTERS WITHOUT MAPPINGS

At Meeting 35 (London, U.K.: September 1998), WG2 directed further study of the characters in the following tables. The Komi letters that were also in the "further study" group were subsequently added to the UCS, and are shown in Section 4.
