Dear Mr.Mike Ksar

After the meeting ISO/IEC/JTC1/SC2 which held in Markham, in Canada, October 24-25, 2004, Mongolian and Chinese joint working group on Phags-pa Script has updated the Proposal.

Hereby, I'm sending you the joint proposal for consideration at the meeting #46 of ISO/IEC/JTC1/SC2/WG2 in Xiamen, China on January 2005. MASM requests following comments should be fully reflected to the next round of ballot, discussed by interested parties.

Comments:

1. Two vowel letters OE and UE and four consonant letters expressing initial consonants of “审, 影, 匣, 非” in Chinese language should be at least added to the list of nominal glyphs.
2. If information processing is taken into consideration, a syllable delimiter, a joiner and its variant are needed.
3. Khubilai Khan font should be used.
4. Three variant selectors are needed.
