Madam,

Please refer this Department's letter of even number dated 5th March, 2008 (copy enclosed) regarding the immediate rectification of Meetei Mayek alphabet accepted by the Unicode Consortium for which no action has so far been taken by the Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, Govt. of India and the Unicode Consortium.

There were several types of Meetei/Meitei Mayek popularly regarded as indigenous alphabet of Manipuri Language. They were different considerably in terms of structure, order, name and number of letters corresponding to different schools/beliefs. Nevertheless, Government of Manipur constituted a high level Meetei Mayek expert committee comprising of the following to find out the correct and accepted "Meetei Mayek" to standardize/unify and develop the same vide Govt. order No. 1/38/SSE/78 dated 16-11-1978(copy enclosed).

The standardized/unified Meetei Mayek recommended by the expert committee mentioned above was recognized and approved by the Government of Manipur vide orders of even number dated 16-04-1980 and 24-04-1980(copies enclosed). The approved alphabet is the only one which has been being introduced ever since in the educational institutions in the state. It is also the only alphabet used in the media in Manipur.

The Meitei Mayek accepted by the Unicode consortium for the purpose of codification to Unicode Standard is absolutely different from the alphabet of Meetei Mayek recognized by the Govt. of Manipur and used by the whole state as specified below.

Therefore, it is informed to encode the following 56 characters of Meetei Mayek, the only alphabet recognized by the Government of Manipur and used by the whole of state, to the Unicode Standard and cancel the unofficial Meitei Mayek of 78 characters accepted by the Unicode Consortium earlier for the same purpose, to avoid further complicacies.
