Title: Hangul Syllable Type examples shown at UAX #29 (a feedback to PRI #138)

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1. Issue Statement

In the section 3.1 Default Grapheme Cluster Boundary Specification of UAX #29, we have Table 2. Grapheme Cluster Break Property Values showing the following rows:

Since the Unicode 5.2 includes new Hangul Jamo characters at *Hangul Jamo* (U+1100–U+11FF), *Hangul Jamo Extended-A* (U+A960–U+A97F), and *Hangul Jamo Extended-B* (U+D7B0–U+D7FF) blocks, it appears at least some of the rows shown at the above need to be updated.

2. Change Proposal

Naturally, there are about two or so approaches that we can take and it appears either one of the two shown at below will achieve the same goal:

2.1. Proposal Option 1: Delete examples from the rows.

In other words, the above five rows can be simplified into the rows shown at below since the HangulSyllableType.txt for the Unicode 5.2 will include the new Jamo characters:

2.2. Proposal Option 2: Insert additional examples into the rows for L, V, and T.

Alternatively, as like the current, we can choose to show all the ranges including the new ones:
