Re: Remove <u>SL</u>, <u>SA</u>, <u>ML</u> data values from UAX #39From: Mark DavisDate: 2014-09-26

The use of the data for <u>SL</u>, <u>SA</u>, <u>ML</u> is discouraged in #39. Their use is dangerous for a number of reasons, as we found out during the development of v7.0 of #39. I recommend that we put out a PRI to remove those tables from v8.0 of UTS#39.

The removal would involve:

- 1. Removing any line containing the values {<u>SL</u>, <u>SA</u>, <u>ML</u>} as the third field value in confusables.txt
 - a. For compatibility, we could retain the third field in the file, but the value would always be MA.
- 2. Modifying ConfusableDataTableTypes
- 3. Making the necessary other changes in the text of #39.

It has the other advantage of making the data file about ¹/₄ the length, and easier to read. (<u>L2014/</u><u>14151</u>)

Note that these values can be derived from the MA tables (plus UCD properties for script, normalization, and casing) if someone wanted to construct their own for some reason.
