

CSS control of emoji presentation

This proposal is a small expansion of a discussion item suggested at the end of [L2/15-275](#).

There is a need for a mechanism in CSS to indicate a preference for the presentation style of characters that can have either a “text” or an “emoji” style of presentation. The preference should permit three values:

- For all such characters, use the “text” presentation style if supported.
- For all such characters, use the “emoji” presentation style if supported.
- For all such characters, use the default presentation style (e.g. as specified in emoji-data) if supported.

Proposal: Unicode should request that W3C enhance CSS to provide such a mechanism.
