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#### 1. Introduction

DPRK once submitted 94 KP1-Source characters to IRG in IRGN897 CJK C1 collection, but the KP column and all the KP1-Source characters had been removed from the collection since C1 v8.0 (WG2 N3134) because of the font issue. DPRK once proposed to add 58 disunifiable characters back to CJK C1 in IRGN1265, but it was too late at that time. There are only 8 KP1-Source characters which are encoded in CJKUI Ext. C as below finally.




Fig. 2.4 Korean Telegraphic Code Book, P. II
