Regarding the following action:

142-A23	Andy Heninger	Investigate whether any other classes should be included in LB22.

Andy did an investigation, and recommended a PRI on a simplification of LB22. I agree with the goal, but think we might just incorporate into a proposed update, which will have its own PRI.

LB22 reads: “Do not break between two ellipses, or between letters, numbers or exclamations and ellipsis.”

[22.02](#) EX × IN

[22.03](#) (ID | EB | EM) × IN

[22.04](#) IN × IN

[22.05](#) NU × IN

This shows be character classes that should not break from an ellipsis ([IN](#)). Currently AL, HL, EX, ID, EB, EM, NU.

The above rules could be simplified to just the following (not allow breaks before an ellipsis).
