Recommendations for Emoji, Unicode 14.0

Background

With the delay of Unicode 14.0 due to COVID-19, our schedule for encoding atomic emoji characters has slipped by ~6 months. As such, we extended the deadline for Unicode 14.0 submissions. This document contains our recommendations, derived from existing provisional emoji candidates and emoji added to larger lists.

II. Proposal Overview

We are proposing a total of thirty-seven emoji draft candidates of which thirty-six require new codepoints (and an additional seventy-five skin tone variants). Of these, 10 are existing provisional candidates. This year the subcommittee prioritized encoding globally relevant concepts belonging to the most <u>frequently used categories</u>. This effort has resulted in the following breakdown listed in order of most to least:

People and Hands: 12
Smileys and Emotion: 9
Animals and Nature: 4

• Objects: 4

• Food and Drink: 3

• Travel and Transportation: 3
