Digit 4, 6 and 7 are NOT available in Unicode.



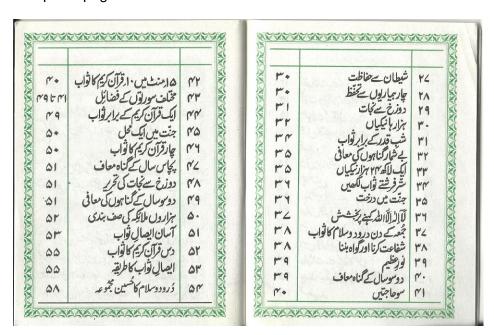
