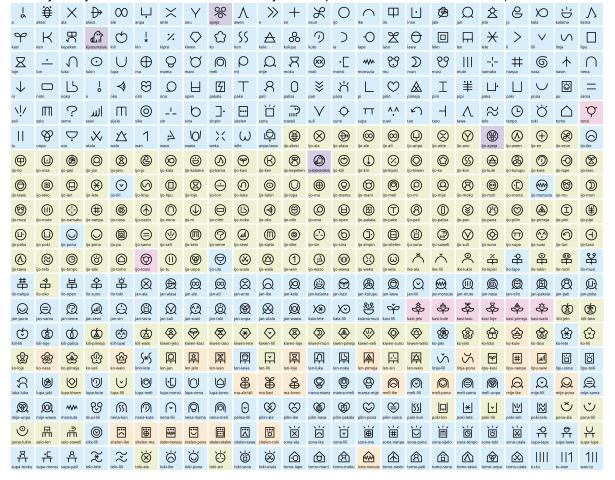

Here is every symbol of sitelen pona, where all symbols up to "wile" are root words and ever word after are compound words made of a root noun and a root adjetive. This includes both Canon words and non-canon words made by speakers that are not official. (and "kijetesantakalu" that was made as a April Fool's joke by its maker but now has a use by some speakers of less canon dialects)



(Note: that there may be other words that might be older or less common that are missing, however as they are not in use anymore there is way less of a need for them in Unicode and they have way less standardization of there glyphs)
