

# Request to Remove Klingon from the “Not on the Roadmap” List

When I brought up the subject of encoding Klingon ꞑIqɑḍ (again) back in 2016, I was told that in order even to get the script considered on its merits, [there needed to be a proposal](#) to rescind motion 87-M3, which placed it on the [list of notices of non-approval at unicode.org](#).

I therefore offer this proposal that Unicode rescind 87-M3 and clear the way for at least some discussion of the propriety of encoding the Klingon script. For support, I point to [L2/16-329](#), which gives many examples of Klingon usage, since [L2/16-329](#) did not explicitly mention rescinding the non-approval.

There are other scripts which are potentially encumbered by intellectual-property issues and which Unicode still permits itself to consider. Because of this, and following the advice linked above, I ask that Klingon at least be placed on equal footing with them.
