This is my personal opinion.


- 1) I have never seen the set of the so-called 9 Hangul strokes before.

- 4) Based on the observations 1) to 3) shown above, I strongly suggest not to include the so-called "Hangul strokes" in UCS (NamesList.txt and ScriptExtensions.txt).
