

Recommendations for ZWJ Sequences, Unicode 15.1

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To: Unicode Technical Committee (UTC)

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I. Background

With the delay of Unicode Version 16.0, our schedule for new atomic emoji will necessarily slip into 2024. However, it is possible to have a release that includes only emoji ZWJ sequences. What follows are our recommendations for Unicode Version 15.1, which includes a total of 578 emoji ZWJ sequences that were derived from provisional emoji candidates, emoji added to larger lists, and priority documents.

II. Recommendations Overview

We are recommending the following 578 emoji ZWJ sequences:
