The UTC (*Unicode Technical Committee*) and other experts in the US have been involved in the following standardization-related activities since IRG Meeting #64 took place:

- 1. Unicode Version 17.0 was successfully released on 2025-09-09:
  - Five characters were added to the Ideographic Symbols and Punctuation block (U+16FF2 through U+16FF6).
  - 18 urgently-needed ideographs were appended to the CJK Unified Ideographs Extension C (6: U+2B73A through U+2B73F) and Extension E (12: U+2CEA2 through U+2CEAD) blocks, filling the former block.
  - 4,298 ideographs were added in the new CJK Unified Ideographs Extension J (U+323B0 through U+33479) block.
  - Four Standardized Variation Sequences (SVSes) for the Sibe (aka Mongolian) forms of the four quotation marks — U+2018, U+2019, U+201C, and U+201D — that use VS3 (Variation Selector 3 or U+FE02) were added.
  - The Unihan Database Lookup page was updated for Unicode Version 17.0.
  - UTN #43 (Unihan Database Property "kStrange"), UTN #45 (Unihan Property History), and UTN #50 (KP-Source Property Value History) were updated for Unicode Version 17.0.
  - The open source Last Resort Font project was updated for Unicode Version 17.0.
- 2. The Unihan database that is associated with Unicode Version 17.0 includes the following noteworthy changes (see UAX #38 for more details):
  - The provisional *kGB7* and *kJa* properties were removed.
  - The new provisional kTayNumeric property was added.
  - The delimiter and description of the kTotalStrokes property were adjusted to allow only one property value.
- 3. A new version of the IVD (*Ideographic Variation Database*) was published on 2025-07-14 that registered the new CAAPH (*Culture and Art Publishing House*) IVD collection and its initial set of 198 IVSes.
- 4. UTC experts reviewed and submitted comments against the UTC-assigned portion of IRG Working Set 2024 Version 3.0, specifically serial numbers 00001 through 01142, prior to the 2025-07-18 deadline, and will have responded to comments against UTC-submitted ideographs by the 2025-09-26 deadline.
- 5. The UTC CJK & Unihan Working Group, which reports to the UTC, continues to meet approximately three weeks prior to each quarterly UTC meeting. See documents L2/25-090 and L2/25-186 for the CJK & Unihan Working Group recommendations that were prepared for the UTC Meetings #183 and #184, respectively. As a reminder, IRG experts are welcome to join the CJK & Unihan Working Group, which meets four times per year as a virtual (Webex) meeting. The next CJK & Unihan Working Group meeting, in preparation for the UTC Meeting #185, is scheduled to take place on 2025-10-10 from 6 to 9PM PDT (GMT Minus 7).
