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

Historical IPA

This pair of historical forms are positional variants of each other.

- 1AE6 ◌̩ COMBINING DOUBLE ARCH BELOW
= turned omega below
→ 032B ◌̩̅ combining inverted double arch below
→ 033C ◌̩̅ combining seagull below
- 1AE7 ◌̨ COMBINING DOUBLE ARCH ABOVE
= turned omega above

Extended IPA positional variants

These are positional variants of diacritics that normally occur below a letter.

- 1AE8 ◌̯ COMBINING EQUALS SIGN ABOVE
→ 0347 ◌̯̅ combining equals sign below
- 1AE9 ◌̮ COMBINING LEFT ANGLE CENTRED ABOVE
→ 031A ◌̮̅ combining left angle above
→ 0349 ◌̮̅ combining left angle below
- 1AEA ◌̰ COMBINING UPWARDS ARROW ABOVE
→ 034E ◌̰̅ combining upwards arrow below
- 1AEB ◌̱ COMBINING DOUBLE RIGHTWARDS ARROW ABOVE
→ 0362 ◌̱̅ combining double rightwards arrow below
