Characters supposed to be unified in SuperCJK 9.0

When reviewing SuperCJK 9.0, we found out that some characters are similar to other existed SuperCJK 9.0 characters and should be unified. Some of these characters may be unified before, but for some reasons, they show up again. We list all these characters in two tables as following:

- Table 1: 70 characters in SuperCJK 9.0 which should be unified to other SuperCJK 9.0 characters
- Table 2: 73 questionable characters in SuperCJK 9.0 may be unified with other SuperCJK 9.0 characters

TCA has two suggestions to dealing with these characters:

- 1. Editorial group should carefully review the characters in Table 1 and 2.
- 2. To combine Table 1 and 2 with TCA's and Japan's proposals for discussing when IRG dealing with CJK Compatibility Ideographs issue.
