The resolution M38.11 instructs project editor for ISO/IEC 10646-1 to include JIS X 0213 COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPHS into a list of characters accepted for processing beyond the 2nd edition of ISO/IEC 10646-1.

This document describes necessary information and proposal for the project editor to accommodate the instruction defined in the resolution M38.11.

Japan requests the editor to include this requirement into the first amendment of the 2nd edition of ISO/IEC 10646-1 which is also instructed to the project editor per resolution M38.14.

Note for both part-1 and part-2 editors (Bruce Paterson and Michel Suignard): To make part-1 and part-2 consistent for the COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPH, please open a discussion about accommodation of this requirement.

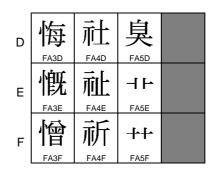
- 1. Code table, character name table and associated changes.
- 1-1. Collection name: Japan requests an independent collection name for these ideographs. The recommended collection name is JIS COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPHS.

Remark: Japan believes that it is not necessary to state " compatibility with which JIS" . Those information should be described in the annex P along with other necessary information.

1-2. Code table: Add following code table as table xxx (xxx to be defined by editor).

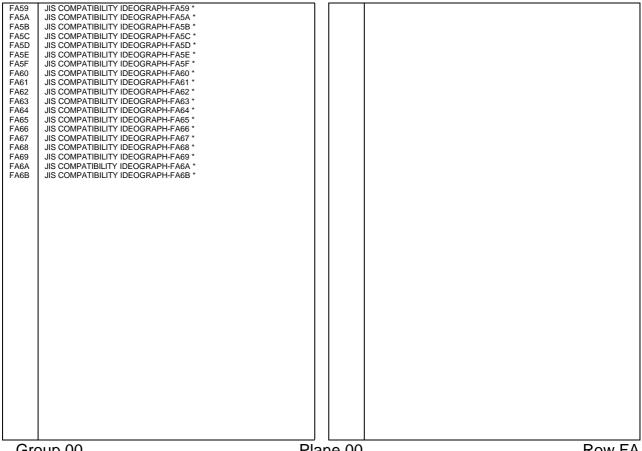
Remark: number of the characters is 60 while the n2197 requested 61. This is per final agreement with the JIS development committee. As a result, the code range is FA30-FA6B.

1-3. Character name: Japan proposes to use the same principle as CJK UNIFIED IDEOGRAPHS/CJK COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPHS for naming of the ANY COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPH (use UCS code position for the naming). The resultant character name is JIS COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPH-FA30 for example (for code point FA30).

Since Japan requests additional information at annex P for those characters, an ASTERISK to be added to indicate the information at the annex P.

- 1-4. Block name and table 3 and 4: It is up to editor, whether if new block name is necessary for those or not. Also, up date of the table 3 and/or 4 or not is up to the editor. Japan does not have any preference on this issue. JIS COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPHS (collection) may (and may not) be a part of the CJK COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPHS (block)
- 1-5. Annex A clause A.1: Add collection JIS COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPHS in clause A.1.
- 1-6. Annex L and clause 27: Try to add a text to explain the rule 13 of the annex L is applicable to the COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPH. (May be rule 13 itself is Okay as it is, However, clause 27 is mentioning CJK UNIFIED IDEOGRAPHS only)).
- 1-7. Annex M: Add JIS X 0213: 2000 7-bit and 8-bit double byte coded extended KANJI sets for information interchange.

Remark: Since ISO/IEC 10646-1 does not use JIS X 0213 as a character naming reference, there is no way to add the JIS into the clause 27. Therefore, the annex M is the best place to add the JIS as a reference standard. (Besides, the part-2 is referring the JIS. Thus, it is necessary to add JIS X 0213: 2000 at clause 10.2.x of the part-2).

2. Compatibility information.

Both N2142 (IRG report regarding COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPHS) and N2196 (Japanese contribution about the COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPHS) are requested to include following information for the COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPHS.

- Corresponding CJK UNIFIED IDEOGRAPH (code point at least)
- Source standard (and code point)

Japan recommends including that information within annex P.

- 2-1. Issue: The annex P is an informative annex, however, Japan believes that that information regarding the COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPHS should be a normative. Japan likes to leave this issue with the editor to resolve.
- 2-2. Annex P: Add following text to annex P

FA30-FA6A JIS COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPH FA30-FA6B Those characters are compatibility ideographs with JIS X 0213: 2000.

Note: a mapping information form the JIS X 0213 to this international standard is available within the JIS X 0213: 2000.

Remark: Japan does not want to add the code point information onto this international standard. It should be a part of the source standard. Reasons are.

- The source standard should have the information and has to keep the right to manage the information (such as up-dating).
- If this international standard also has the information, it may have a danger of the inconsist referring. The reference should be one direction and never be a bi-directional.
- 3. Other concerns: Besides the above, Japan does believe that following to be considered.
- 3-1. Adding a definition of the COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPHS. For better understanding of the relation between CJK UNIFIED IDEOGRAPHS and CJK COMPATIBILITY IDEOGRAPHS, it might be better to include a explanatory text like in N21 96 as a part of the ISO/IEC 10646.
- 3-2. The text might be a part of the definition clause, an independent clause in main text or independent

- annex which might include other information such as information described in para-2 of this draft (as a part of annex P).
- 3-3. There is a possibility to move the corresponding CJK UNIFIED IDEOGRAPH information from annex P (as proposed in pare-2) to the parenthesized information along with the character name. This may (may not) soften the normative/informative discussion of the annex P.
- 3-4. By the way, some of the information in the annex P might have a nature of normative also (such as Glyph table for FA1F and FA23).

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
