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A new proposal for 2286 Nom characters was recompiled by Vietnam IRG members, based on the two previous proposals and checked against SuperCJK14, and was submitted to IRG to be considered for Extension C.

Beside that Vietnam proposes to modify the mapping table in SuperCJK and ISO-IEC 10646 for Chu Nom by adding 949 characters existed in Vietnam sources but not yet proposed into IRG repertoire before.

Activities in implementation for Nom characters are carried out. A project to publish a new Chu Nom dictionary is realized by the Institute of Sino-Nom Studies. Beside that, an other project to develop a Chu Nom dictionary on Web and network is also proceeded with the support from The Nom Preservation Foundation. A search engine for Chu Nom is also build.

Some groups for making Nom fonts were set up to build Nom fonts with its particulars. During this process, some defects in mapping Chu Nom characters in their sources and their positions in ISO-IEC 10646 and SuperCJK 14 were found. A list of these defects is submitted to IRG to consider in the next publication of ISO-IEC 10646.

A proposal for develop a national standrsd on Nom script including all Nom characters in ISO-IEC 10646 is proposed to realize in this year.

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
