After IRG#20 Hanoi, Chinese linguists met and discussed the need of CJK subset. A character list (6,944) was generated on the bases of the being developed ***Standardized Hanzi list*** (規範漢字表). See China's proposal please.

The Chinese linguists also researched the need of encoding of Old Hanzi (古漢字) in ISO/IEC 10646. A proposal will be submitted to IRG#21.

During SARS period, Chinese IRG editors kept working for IRG and WG2 tasks.

China is preparing her CJK_C2 proposal but no timetable so far.

GB 13000-2003 is under translation according to ISO/IEC 10646-2003.
