TCA found there were many wrong unification cases in the reports for reviewing CJK-C1 glyphs (refer to the attached file “[wrong-dup.xls](#)”), because someone didn’t follow the unification rules mentioned in [the Annex S of ISO/IEC 10646-1: 2000](#). In order to clarify the review work for CJK-C1, We proposed the following principles:

1. Two CJK-C1 glyphs should not be unified if there was no any unification rule in the Annex S of ISO/IEC 10646-1:2000 said that they must be unified.
2. If two CJK-C1 glyphs must be unified by a unification rule and a reviewer didn’t agree with that, the reviewer has to provide the copy of any document containing the evident of the difference between these glyphs.
