## 1. Job done:

As decided at IRG#21, editors from IRG China, Japan, TCA and HKSAR rechecked their “evidences” on questionable characters from CJK\_C1 candidates. They reviewed all items in D1 set and D2 set, even in M1 set which was considered “should be removed from CJK\_C1” before IRG#21.

After two rounds reviewing, the chief editor generated 4 refined “evidences” lists according to final feedbacks from China, HKSAR and TCA:

RefinedJapan.xls  
RefinedHKSAR.xls  
RefinedTCA.xls

These lists have been transferred to the technical editor to generate a complete list with glyphs.

## 2. Current Status:
