As decided at IRG#23, IRG editors reviewed CJK-C1 for 2 rounds (but schedule was postponed during holidays in May), I received reports from China, Japan, R.O. Korea, D.P.R. Korea, Hong Kong SAR, Macao SAR and TCA. The IRG Technical Editor generated E41 set, E42 set and D42 set according to the IRG Chief Editor's consolidated comments.

According to DPRK's proposal (no document number, but distributed by the IRG Chief Editor), 20 DPRK characters were removed and 3 characters were get back to E42 set.

The CJK_C1 group agreed to make 250 IDSs (Ideographic Description Sequences) as a trial for review of CJK_C1 after IRG#23. Dr. Lu Qin and Mr. Taichi Kawabata prepared some examples and rules (IRG N1107 and N1108.) but no comments or trials presented by other editors.

There are 19,381 characters in E 42 and 1850 characters in D42.

There are 20,768 code points from U+2A6E0(CJK Unified Ideographs Extension B) through 2F800(CJK Compatibility Ideographs Supplement), I suggest to finish CJK_C1 at IRG#25 and assign them to this area. I also suggest to start CJK_C2 (or CJK_D) at IRG#26.
