Publication of Unicode 4.1

Version 4.1 of the Unicode standard was published on 31 March 2005. This continues the process of synchronizing Unicode and ISO/IEC 10646. It includes some 9,000 new characters, including additional Han ideographs and compatibility ideographs.

This version includes an update to the Unihan database. We remind IRG members that Unicode maintains a large database of information on Han ideographic characters. We are beginning the work of coordinating our data with Vietnam's Nom Preservation Foundation to improve the Vietnamese reading and related data.
