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After the 25<sup>th</sup> meeting of ISO/IRG in Berkeley, USA, the Committee for Unification of Computer Chinese Character Encoding in Macao SAR has participated in reviewing the CJK Extension C1 version 6.0 (N1184) and 6.1 (N1194).

For CJK C1 v6.1, we found that there are 3 characters submitted by Macao SAR are in U set, which we do not suggest to have them unified. Also, we found that 3 characters submitted by us before are currently missing in the CJK Extension C1 v6.1 files. Detailed Macao comments to CJK C1 v6.1 are consolidated in the document N1202.

Internally, the consultation process to various government departments, regarding our “Unification Framework of Computer Chinese Characters Encoding”<sup>1</sup> has completed. We are now analyzing the comments collected from the consultation. Basically, we are to promote the adoption of ISO 10646 standard for Chinese information exchange among government departments, and between government and public in the Macao SAR. We will finalize the framework solution soon.

Due to intensive working schedule, we sincerely apologize not be able to join the
