1. As required by IRG#26, the Chinese old hanzi experts<sup>1</sup> prepared an oracle scripts table for consideration at IRG#27. When preparing this table, the old hanzi experts found that some technical rules may need more review and correction, they suggest the Old Hanzi Group to consider them at IRG#27.
2. The ***Press and Publishing Used Chinese Character Set***<sup>2</sup> of The General Administration of the Press and Publication<sup>3</sup> was developed by Zhonghua Book Company<sup>4</sup>. The character set collects over 10,000 ideographs, 4,000 of them are accepted by ***Hanyu Da Zidian***<sup>5</sup>. The rest are mostly used for ancient books. All 10,000 ideographs are not encoded in CJK+A+B. These ideographs are selected from 500 important ancient books covering 200,000,000 characters.
3. The National Library<sup>6</sup> refined their preliminary proposal<sup>7</sup> for CJK\_D or CJK\_E. The preliminary proposal contains 4,952 characters including glyphs, Kangxi indexes, Kangxi radicals, stroke counts, first stroke, source information and images from original books.
4. The Business Press<sup>8</sup> is now building a database for philology and lexicography. The preliminary checking shows that there are 3,000 to 4,000 characters are not encoded in standards.
5. The Founder Electronics and Zhongyi Electronics<sup>9</sup> re-checked some characters out of CJK\_C1 and prepared their “evidences”, for future CJK extension. These characters are used for people’s name and place names, 1,800 of them are provided by the Chinese Academy of Surveying and

## Mapping<sup>10</sup>.
