






1. R.O.Korea suggests that, in NB's comments/feedbacks, NB indicate relevant component(s) of CJK characters "in red circles/boxes" so that other people can easily identify components in question. This will make a review process more efficient and thus save time.

#### 4.3 Guidelines for comments

a. When a comment claims that component(s) of a glyph is wrong, the relevant component(s) of ideographs need to be indicated in red circles/boxes in comments files.

Similarly, when a comment claims that components of two or more Ideographs are the same or different, the corresponding components of two or more ideographs need to be indicated in red circles/boxes in comments files.
