1. Reviewing work on CJK-B multi-column ideographic code chart:

According to the resolution IRG M36.3, TCA had collected totally 207 T-glyphs that should be changed from appendix files of IRG N1775 CJK Editorial Group Report. Then TCA submitted the code list and delta ttf file for changing those 207 T-source glyphs to CJK editors and WG2 project editor on July 1, 2011. In addition, TCA submitted the revised delta ttf file of those 207 glyphs on July 6, 2011. TCA also reviewed the consolidated comments on IRG N1784 CJK-B code charts and collected totally 23 T-glyphs that should be changed. Then TCA submitted the document for responding IRG N1784 and the delta list and ttf file for changing those 23 T-source glyphs to IRG chief editor and WG2 project editor before this meeting. By the way, totally 230 T-glyph had been changed for revising the CJK-B code chart.

2. The Old Hanzi ad hoc meeting at Taipei:

Based on the resolution IRG M36.7, TCA/CMEX hosted the first Old Hanzi ad hoc meeting at Taipei on September 26 - 29, 2011. In this meeting, the attendees had discussed the consolidated comments for the oracle-bone glyphs with SW radical #76 - #300 and made some conclusions about old Hanzi reviewing work. Japan will host next Old Hanzi ad hoc meeting at Tokyo on January 2012.

3. The continuous promotion for CNS 11643 repertoire:

In order to promote the CNS 11643 repertoire, the IMC of DGBAS (the Information Management Center of the Directorate-General of Budget, Accounting and Statistics) held 15 seminars from August to October 2011. Those seminars introduce the coding scheme of CNS 11643, and the content and usage methods of the CNS 11643 repertoire. Totally 602 people attended or sign up those seminars.
