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Activity Report of Vietnam

1. CJK_B multi-column code charts Issues

Viet Nam has updated CJK_B Vietnam font for questioned cases in CJK_B, based on the documents IRGN1748 and sent it to the editor.

2. CJK_E_V62 review

Vietnam has reviewed all the glyphs in CJK_E_V62 and sent feedbacks to the chief editor for the document IRGN1779

3. Standardization activities

Vietnam has published Vietnamese standard TCVN 8271-1,2,3,4,5,6 in 2009 and 2010 for Vietnamese quoc ngu, Chu Nom, Thai, Cham, Khmer scripts. The national standard is still pending for the last section TCVN 8271-7, which covers all Chu Nom characters in Extension E.

Vietnam IT Technical Committee is developing Vietnamese versions of ISO/IEC 15836 (Dublin core), ISO/IEC 2382 (terminology), ISO/IEC 5138 (office equipments), ISO/IEC 9995 (keyboard), ISO/IEC 20000 (services management), ISO/IEC 27000 (information security).

4. Hosting IRG meeting in Hanoi

The Vietnam Standard Institute would like the IRG to consider Hanoi as a place for IRG#39 meeting on the fall of 2012. At the moment, the meeting has been approved by the Vietnam's STAMEQ (Standards, Metrology and Quality).

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
