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1. After the IRG#36 in Chongqing, China, the Computer Chinese Characters Encoding Workgroup has submitted the IRGN 1791, which includes the MSARG font of our characters submitted to CJK Ext. E, totally 56 characters. We are looking forward to working with IRG members for the inclusion of those characters in CJK Ext. E in this meeting.
2. The Workgroup is going to establish the MISCS<sup>1</sup> unification standard in Macao government in the coming year. Macao public departments will use it as the information exchange encoding standard. We are going to study the encoding schemes, prepare publication documents, plan for the technical implementation, and liaise with industrial partners for the unification framework.
