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1. Attending WG2#59

Chinese delegation attended the WG2#59 in Mountain View in February 2012 for CJK issues and proposals on Chinese minorities' scripts and ancient scripts.

2. Attending Old Hanzi meeting

Experts from Beijing Normal University and technicians from the China Electronic Standardization Institute attended the Old Hanzi meeting in Tokyo in February 2012. The experts from mainland of China are continuing the work of old hanzi encoding. We welcome helps, cooperation and comments from other experts.

3. Preparation of CJK_F

We are collecting un-encoded ideographs for candidates of the coming CJK_F. We have collected 1,000 more characters of Square Zhuang Script (方塊壯字) which was designed for recording Zhuang language, by simulating the design of Hanzi. We think these characters should be encoded in CJK like some of Vietnamese Hanzi (字喃).

It is roughly estimated that thousands characters including Zhuang Characters and Hanzi will be proposed before IRG#39.
